Field Hockey Terminology

Attack (Attacker) – The team (player) which (who) is trying to score a goal.

Defense (Defender) – The team (player) which (who) is trying to prevent a goal from being scored.

Back-line – The shorter perimeter line.

Goal-line – The back-line between the goal posts.

Side-line – The longer perimeter line.

Striking Circle – The area enclosed by and including the two quarter circles and the lines joining them at each end of the field opposite the center of the back-lines.

Hit – Striking the ball using a swinging movement of the stick towards the ball.

Push – Moving the ball along the ground using a pushing movement of the stick after the stick has been placed close to the ball. When a push is made, both the ball and the head of the stick are in contact with the ground.

Flick – Pushing the ball so that it is raised off the ground.

Offence – An action contrary to the Rules which may be penalized by an umpire.
